Review of SQR:

- Observations of SQR team have been seen in classrooms by the Team Lead.
- Felt that sometimes the comments made by the observers seemed as if they haven't been in a classroom as a teacher.
- Comm. Liaison noticed some things that parents are also discussing: safety in hallways and classroom issues, low level rigor.
- Parent felt that the ratings seemed a bit harsh, but agrees that her child is not being challenged.
- Teacher wondered if any electives classes had been included in the observation. Yes - they observed in all areas of the building.
- Question of the balance of responsibility between rigor and behavior. Is rigor lacking b/c of behavior interruptions, or is behavior what it is b/c students don't feel challenged.
- Principal take-away, we have to increase rigor.

Budget
