Rainbow Alley - "Gender Queeries" - 1st Friday from 6-7pm

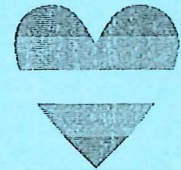
Saturday:

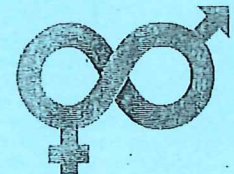
Rainbow Alley - "Gender Queeries Parent Group" - 1st Friday from 6-7pm
