LEARNING OPTION UPDATE

If you would like to request to change your student's learning option selection (in-person or virtual) for the Spring (January through May 2021), please complete this form.

If you would like to keep your student's learning option selection from Fall 2020, no further action is required. You can check your student's current learning option selection by going to Parent Portal or by calling your student's school.

We will make every effort to accommodate all requests for changes. However, your selection is not confirmed until you hear directly from the school.

- 1. This change window is for middle and high schools, including 6th -8th graders at ECE-8th grade schools. Sixth graders at Montessori schools are not eligible for this change window.*

Due to health restrictions on the number of interactions with adults and other students outside of your child's cohort, some services related to special education, 504 Plan, English Language Acquisition (ELA), Gifted and Talented (GT), or others might be delivered through live streaming into your child's classroom.*
- 3. To the extent your child is on an individualized education plan (IEP) or 504 Plan, choices related to online-only learning may need to be reviewed with your child's IEP or 504 Team to determine whether your child has services or needs that can only be addressed in an in-person environment.*

INTERNET ACCESS

If your student is enrolled in a Virtual Program, or in the event that your student's school is required to transition to remote learning during the school year, your student will need internet access. If you select "yes," you are indicating that your student has reliable access to the internet at home, either through a personal account or district-issued hotspot. If you select "no," you are indicating that your student needs internet access at home and you may be contacted about next steps.
