




Translations






MI PROGRAM SHOUTOUT!

District Interim Test Results

Math:

6th Grade:

-Closed the achievement gap completely

7th grade:

-Over 50% of our students Meet or Exceed standards on BOTH Interims (last year 6th grade was 26% Meets/Exceeds on Interim 2)

8th grade:

-Closed achievement gap by 10 percentage points

Language Arts:

6th Grade:

Still being administered and graded

7th Grade:

Increased percentage of students Meeting or exceeding by 10%

8th Grade:

Increased percentage of students Meeting or exceeding by 11%
